What is Formative Assessment?

Making informed teaching and learning decisions



Purpose


Use assessment information to understand how students are progressing in their learning and what can be done next to help them improve.

Who & How

Teachers: use assessment information to determine effectiveness of instruction, and adjust to support students

Students: use assessment information to determine strengths and what to work on next to grow

3 Key Questions



Throughout the learning process, students can answer the questions in the **GREEN** box to help their learning.

Teachers can answer the questions in YELLOW to ensure they are supporting students in learning.

Feedback



Teachers provide descriptive feedback related to the learning success criteria

- Strength based language for what the student demonstrated
- Suggestive language for what the student can do next
- Time in class for students to apply feedback

Self Assessment

- Students use success criteria to determine where they are currently at in their learning.
- They consider strengths and area(s) to grow, and set a goal to progress their learning.
- Create a plan to achieve goal and work toward it.
